\**Huck* Journal #1 – What are some of the events in Huck’s life that have influenced his ways of thinking about slavery, religion, and/or deception? How does his behavior suggest he might be immature in his moral development (Kohlberg’s Level I)? (1 page)

\**Huck* Journal #2 - Write about one or more of the events in the novel from Jim's point of view instead of Huck's. Show how his hopes, fears, desires, and past experiences have an impact on how he sees the event. (1 page)

\**Huck* Journal #3 – In what ways does Huck show signs of having progressed to Kohlberg’s Level II in his morals? Level II is the Conventional/Role Conformity stage when the person bases his/her morals on conformity to society, laws, and not “rocking the boat.” (1 page)

\**Huck* Journal #4: Why was the Disney movie of *The Adventures of Huckleberry Finn* changed? Identify several specific changes and explain how they contrast with the novel. Then explain why these changes were probably made.
