

**Controversial Speech**  
Changing Views of Right and Wrong

**Prompt:** Identify an activity, practice, policy, etc. that is thought, by most people, to be acceptable and right. Give a 2-3 minute speech in which you explain why you believe this practice to be wrong. Be sure to back up your statements with anecdotes, statistics, and expert opinions. Anticipate counter-arguments to your point of view. Conclude by stating what you believe should be done about it.

**Content**

Introduction – Begin with a hook. State the issue and your main points. \_\_\_\_\_/10
