

Spanish Skit

Create a skit in Spanish to be performed in front of the class. One student should type up the skit and print it for everyone. Rehearse the skit during class time so that you have memorized your lines. Use any vocabulary and grammar that we have learned since the beginning of the year. Do not use vocabulary and verb tenses that we have not learned (for example, no past tense or future tense).

Scenario #1: You go to the grocery store or a restaurant (alone or with others) and run into some friends.

Scenario #2: You go to a school dance at another school. Have a conversation with the people you meet.

Requirements:

- Everyone in the skit says at least two sentences
- Ask at least five questions
- Use at least five different verbs
- Conjugate the verbs correctly in the questions and responses
- Use at least one form of gustar or encantar
