

I. Lifestyle Section

- a. Describe the physical and socio-economical environment in which the majority of the population lives.
- b. What is the primary language? Are there others used? Explain.
- c. Do they enjoy material comforts like some U.S. citizens? Explain.
- d. Describe the labor force employed.
- e. Describe leisure and entertainment activities.

II. Religion Section

- a. What are the main religions practiced? Does one tend to dominate the others?
- b. Does religion influence the political order of your country's society? Explain why or why not.
- c. What are some of the major religious customs that are practiced?
- d. Major holidays observed?
- e. Are there any non-religious customs practiced?

III. Domestic Problems and Issues

- a. Identify any major environmental problems? Are measures being taken to combat them?
- b. What are the main health problems?
- c. What are the main political problems or issues? (Examples – Constant civil unrest, EU membership, political lobbyists)
- d. What are the major economic problems?

IV. International views and problems

- a. Are there any international disputes or wars?
- b. How do citizens view immigration? As a problem or is it acceptable? Explain.
- c. Is there a feeling of isolationism in practice or international cooperation and trade?
